## **BASIC FUNCTION OF POSITION**

Incumbent assists Consular Section Staff with a variety of duties in customer service, processing visa and passport applications, responding to inquiries from applicants, and processing claims for U.S. federal benefits.

## **QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED**

All applicants must address each selection criterion detailed below with specific information supporting each item.

**EDUCATION:** Present enrollment in a university or secretary/language school.

**EXPERIENCE:** Some experience in customer service is required.

**LANGUAGE:** Level IV (fluent) German language skills and Level III English (good working knowledge) are required.

## **KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:**

- Knowledge of clerical procedures.
- Good typing skills are required – (Level II – 40 wpm).
- Computer skills with background in EXCEL and WORD.

Please note that the Human Resources Office may conduct tests of appropriate language levels, or other required skills during the interview process.

## APPLICATION INFORMATION

- **Selection Process:** It is essential that the candidate specifically address the required qualifications in the application.
- **Additional Selection Criteria:**
  1. The U.S. Mission will consider nepotism/conflict of interest, budget, and residency status, and whether applicant has a work permit, in determining successful candidacy.
  2. The candidate must be able to obtain and hold a non-sensitive security clearance.
